## Fatal car accident in Ste. Clotilde

A tragic accident occurred on Grand Rang in Ste. Clotilde about 3:40 p.m. Jan. 31,\* which claimed the life of **Gina Bigras**. She was 20 years old.

Ms. Bigras was the daughter of **Gilles Bigras** and **Donna Nichilo**. Mr. Bigras had been the St. Jean Chrysostome mayor for several years before accepting a position as riding assistant to Beauharnois-Huntingdon MNA **Andre Chenail**.

The road conditions at the accident site near #1033 were snow-covered and very slippery.

Apparently the car went out of control, entered

into a skid and collided with a truck coming from the opposite direction.

Agent **Gilles Savoie** of Ste. Martine Surete du Quebec arrived at the accident scene. The victim was taken by ambulance to the Anna-Laberge Hospital in Chateauguay where she was pronounced dead.

Besides her parents, **Gina Bigras** is survived by her three sisters, **Michelle, Tammy and Joanna**. She also leaves her fiancé, **Ken Drysdale**; their engagement was celebrated just a month ago.

Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m., Feb. 5, at the parish church in St. Chrysostome.
