

## Margaret Quenneville 1907-1992

Mrs. Margaret Quenneville passed away quietly at the Barrie Memorial Hospital on Thursday May 21. The funeral mass was celebrated in Saint-Anicet Saturday, May 23.

Margaret was born in Saint-Anicet August 21, 1907. She was the second of six children born to Francis and Catherine (Moriarty) Quenneville.

Maggie left Leahy Road to begin a long career in hospital work beginning in 1943 at the Pearly Home in Ottawa. She went to Montreal in 1948 and for the next 25



years worked in the Montreal Children's Hospital, Saint-Mary's Hospital and finally retired in 1972 from The Montreal General Hospital.

She was well known for her volunteer work at the General Hospital and her beloved Saint-Kevin's Church.

She was fond of children and enjoyed visiting her extended family of nieces and nephews.

Failing health caused her to return to the Chateauguay Valley in 1988. She is survived by three brothers: Henry (wife Helen), Michael, and John Quenneville. Her sister Mary (Mrs. Humphrey Thurston) and brother James predeceased Margaret.
