Drowning

In separate incidents over the weekend, police report the discovery of two bodies, both victims of accidental death, they believe.

The body of Marcelle Gatién, 75, of Lachine, was found last Saturday around 7 p.m., floating near a private wharf at 49th Ave. in St-Anicet, where she and a sister had rented a cottage for the summer.

The victim was discovered by neighbors she'd been visiting earlier in the afternoon, after her sister called to say she had not returned home for supper.

Gatién was taken by ambulance to the Suroît Regional Hospital in Valleyfield, where she was pronounced dead.

A preliminary investigation conducted by the Huntingdon Sûreté du Québec suggests the victim lost consciousness after entering the lake near her cottage. Police are waiting for the results of an autopsy.

St-Antoine-Abbé death

The body of James McNeilly, 44, of Bourdeau St. in St-Antoine-Abbé, was found in his residence by an employer who went to find out why the victim had failed to appear for work.

The body was discovered around 5:45 p.m. on Friday, Aug. 8.

Police said the victim had died the day before, and they are waiting for an autopsy report to determine the cause of death. Neither foul play nor suicide is suspected in this case.
