Youth dies in car accident

A young man, only 17 years old, died early Saturday morning in an accident involving a single vehicle.

The victim was Wayne Ykema, a resident of Dewittville.

At the time of the accident, he was alone in his car, a 1985 Ford, driving east on Route 138 in the municipality of Godmanchester. His car turned over near the intersection

of White Station Road and he was caught under his vehicle. It was about 1:30 a.m.

Officers Jacques Bernier and Robert Verge of the Huntingdon detachment of the SQ were called to the scene of the accident.

Young Ykema was taken by ambulance to Huntingdon County Hospital where Dr. Jean-Pierre Hébert pronounced him dead.
