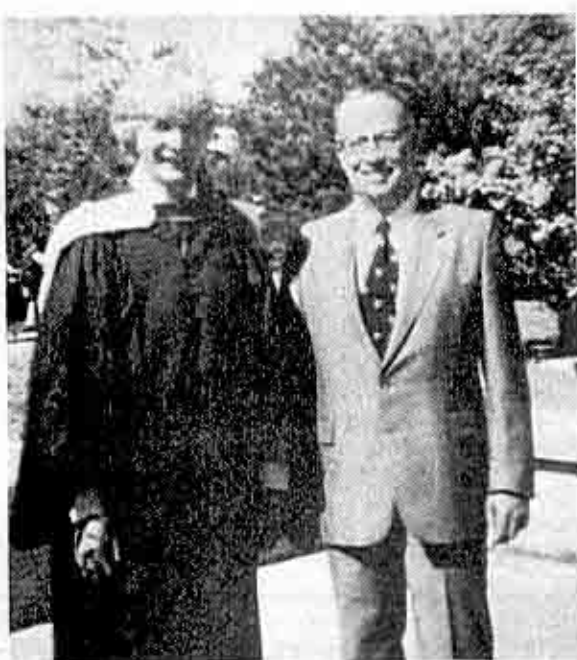
Moore-Perry wedding held in Plattsburg
