Young girl fatally hit by car

A young girl, aged 10, was fatally struck by a car as she was walking along Church Street in Ormstown, on Monday, Dec. 23 at 4:50 p.m.

Her name was Jasmine Gagne, of Vanier. She was visiting a relative in Ormstown.

The car involved in the fatal accident was driven by Jacques Thomas of Ormstown. He was driving a 1983 Datsun, owned by Joel Lussier of St. Antoine Abbe.

Officer Gaetan Dubois of the Ste-Martine Detachment of the QPP was called to the scene of the accident to make the preliminary report. He was put in charge of the investigation. More news will be fortheoming concerning the accident as charges are expected to be laid.

Police are still investigating a fatal accident which occurred on Wednesday, Dec. 18 in Orm-St. Malachie stown's Parish,

The accident which took place around 12:20 p.m. and involved a trailer truck and a car, resulted in the Antonio death of Dumouchel, aged 60 of Valleyfield,

The district coroner has been advised of the death. But it appears the tragic event will be ruled as totally accidental.
