## Ormstown native dies in Malone

Andrew W. Cavanagh, 87, of Constable Street Road, Malone, N.Y. died Tuesday, Feb. 25 in Alice Hyde Hospital after a lengthy illness.

Born in Ormstown, Que. on August 28, 1898, he was the son of Peter and Katherine (McKeegan) Cavanagh.

He went to Malone in 1927. He was a farm laborer all of his working years and
