## Two die in motorcycle crash

An accident involving a motorcycle and a motor home took place around 4:34 p.m. on July 5, resulting in the death of two young men.

The tragic incident happened going south on Route 201, near the Lac des Pins camping grounds, not far from the village of St. Antoine-Abbé.

The victims were William Henderson, 23, who lived on Route 138 near Huntingdon, and Marc Lessard of the Boyd Settlement in Hinchinbrooke, who was to celebrate his 18th birthday

on July 7.

At the time of the accident, William Henderson was driving a Suzuki motorcycle, while Marc Lessard was riding as a passenger.

The other vehicle involved was driven by Lucien Sabourin of L'Orignal, Ont. No one in the motor home was hurt.

Officers Dennis Clapp and Eugene Gagnon of the Huntingdon QPP witnessed the fatal accident, as they happened to be on the spot, investigating the circumstances of another

accident.

The victims were taken by the Inter-municipal Ambulance Service to the Barrie Memorial Hospital in Ormstown where Dr. Blonde pronounced them dead.

According to the police preliminary report, the motor home wanted to turn left to enter the Lac des Pins Camping while the motorcycle was trying to pass it. The motorbike smashed directly into the motor home, killing the driver and passenger instantly.
