Highway fatality

A traffic accident which occurred at 15 minutes past midnight on Sunday, June 21 caused the death of a young man only 24 years old.

The victim is Gerry Duhème of the Smellie Side Road in the Municipality of Godmanchester,

At the time of the accident, Duhéme was riding a moped. A collision occurred between the moped and a Corvette driven by Richard Ricard, domiciled at 4 Somerville Street in Huntingdon.

Gerry Duhème was taken by Montpetit Ambulance to the Emergency Ward of the Barrie Memorial Hospital, from where he was immediately transferred to a hospital in Montreal. He died as a result of his wounds around 5:30 a.m.

Officers Yvan Lemelin and Jacques Bernier of the Huntingdon detachment of the Provincial Police were called to the scene of the accident, which took place opposite no. 2170 of the Ridge Road.

An investigation is underway to determine the exact circumstances of the tragic accident.
