19-year-old killed in traffic accident

A 19-year-old young man from St-Chrysostome was killed in a traffic accident on March 4, around 7 p.m.

The accident, involving a single vehicle, caused the death of Roger Boileau, jr., whose address was 237, Rang St-Louis in St-Chrysostome.

The accident took place on route 205 in St-Urbain. According to the first findings by the police, the accident was due to the driver losing control of the vehicle, perhaps due to excessive speed, because it happened on a straight stretch of road.

A passenger in the vehicle - a 1988 Comanche Jeep - Maurice Dufour, 20 years old, of Ville Mercier, was seriously hurt in the accident and is presently hospitalized in Montreal.

The victim was taken by ambulance to the Barrie Memorial Hospital in Ormstown where Dr. Brissette pronounced him dead.
