Indian killed in St. Regis

A 22-year-old North American Indian of St. Regis Quebec was killed around 3 a.m. on April 29, at his home located on St. Regis Street. It seems that a fight between two people ended in the death of Richard Lazore.

A resident of 2nd street in St. Regis, by the name of Sheldon Jacob, only 18 years old, surrendered to the Indian Police a short while after the tragic incident. He was taken to the Mohawk Police Station where he gave himself up to Sergeant Westley Benedict.

It was learned that the victim had his head hit many times with a carpenter's level. The St. Regis Reservation

Emergency Unit found the victim already dead when it arrived on the premises.

The Mohawk Police immediately contacted the Huntingdon detachment of the Quebec Provincial Police to help them with the investigation. The Unit of Crimes against persons of the Provincial Police has sent officer Mantha to look into the matter. He will be working with officer Richard Bernique of the Huntingdon QPP, and constable Lewis Mitchell of the Mohawk Police.

Sheldon Jacob appeared in the Valleyfield Court on Monday afternoon, May 2, to answer charges. He will remain in the Valleyfield jail pending preliminary investigation.
