### Sudden Death

Word was received here on Thursday, May 5, of the sudden death of Lisle Watterson, at his home in Caledonia, Ont.

The funeral service took place in the Millar Funeral Chapel in Caledonia on Sat. May 7 at 2 p.m.

Lisle's remains were later cremated and his ashes were brought to Dundee on Sat. May 14, for burial in the family plot at Zion Church Cemetery. Close family members were in attendance.

When Lisle was visiting just recently, he was telling of his experiment feeding wild birds this past winter. He was amazed at how much money could be spent this way, but since he had derived much pleasure doing it he felt it was all worthwhile.
