## Sudden death of Metro store manager

Huntingdon and the surrounding countryside was shocked and saddened to learn of the untimely death of Adelard Paul Ross, who died of a massive coronary in the hospital at Valleyfield on Saturday, June 18, 1988.

The deceased was born in Montreal on September 19, 1937. He is survived by his wife Bonnie Zwicker of Nova Scotia, and 2 daughters, Dale Hayward

and Nancy Ross, all of whom reside in Franklin Centre, Que. Two sisters also survive him, Cecile Dean and Annette Ross Casavant and one brother, Maurice, all of Montreal.

Ross, as he was familiarly known, was an affable person, and well-known to the Huntingdon area. He had worked for over 20 years in the I.G.A. Supermarkets. At the time of his death he was acting manager of the Metro Store

in Huntingdon, and in the short time he had worked there had proved himself a valued and much appreciated employee.

A memorial service was held at Sharpe's Funeral Home in Franklin Centre on Sunday evening, June 19 where his many relatives and friends gathered to show their respect for this fine gentleman.

Interment will be made in Pictou, N.S.
