The day after his birthday, Jimmy Van der Heyden lost his life in a car accident on May 6 at 5:45 a.m.

This young man, who lived at 7170 Dundee Center Road in Dundee was alone driving his Chevette '84 car. According to police reports, the accident occurred due to loss of control on a curve in front of #4598 Ridge Road. The victim hit a stone wall and

the car returned to the road on its roof.

According to information released, the young man, aged 23 was killed on impact. His death was verified by doctor Jean Rosenberg. The body of the victim was taken by ambulance Montpetit to his morgue.

Agent Denis Cardinal of the Huntingdon QPF arrived at the scene to verify this fatal accident.
