TRIBUTE TO MR. SERGE D'AMOUR

The Ormstown Lions Club wishes to pay tribute to one of its founding members, Mr. Serge D'Amour, who passed away on April 14th, 1990. Mr. D'Amour was well-known for his numerous contributions to the community. He had been a member of the Ormstown Lions Club since 1961 and had acted as president during the years 1968-1969 and 1977-78. Moreover, Mr. D'Amour served in the following public functions over the years:

- 1) founding member of the Ormstown Caisse Populaire from November 1958 to April 1964
- 2) school commissioner for the Ormstown Catholic School Board from June 1963 to June 1966. He was elected president at the beginning of his term at the first assembly.
- 3) member of the Recreational Services from 1963 to 1970
- 4) councillor for the village of Ormstown from November 1969 to November 1971 (seat #2)
- 5) church warden for the Catholic Church of Ormstown from January 1973 to December 1975
- 6) member of the Administrative Council of the Barrie Memorial Hospital from August 1st, 1986 to June 15th, 1989
- 7) co-founder of the Upper St. Lawrence Chamber of Commerce from November 1987 to November 1989

Mr. Serge D'Amour was a leader, a man of action. He was valued for his firm beliefs, his frankness, his self-assurance, his good judgment, his integrity, his intellectual curiosity, his openness, his respect for differences, his enthusiasm, and his ability to both listen and make himself heard. The member of Mr. Serge D'Amour should inspire us all in our various community activities.
