## Former mayor Wilbert Orr succumbs to pneumonia

Wilbert Orr passed away May 24, 1991 at Centre d'Accueil, Ormstown, Quebec at the age of 87. Wilbert was raised on a dairy farm on Fertine Creek in Howick. As a young man his entrepreneurial spirit led him to pursue a commerce in Montreal. After an absence of several years, Wilbert returned to manage the family farm. He married Irene Black and they moved to Ormstown upon his retirement.

Mr. Orr served as Mayor of the Parish of Tres-St. Sacrement from 1963 to 1965. He was a lifetime member of the Shriners Organization and a former Grand Patron. Wilbert was a talented musician who played in the Shriners Band. He played a variety of instruments: the harmonica,

violin and the organ. Over the years, Wilbert was a generous benefactor of the Shriners Hospital. His name is enshrined in the gold book in recognition of his generosity and compassion.

Predeceased by his wife Irene, Wilbert was a resident of Centre d'Accueil from 1985 until his death. I would like to commend the nursing staff and the aids for their dedication, professionalism and humanitarianism.
