## The late Charles Gordon Crawford

Charles Crawford Gordon passed away at the Grandview Lodge Nursing Home, Dunnville, Ontario, on June 27, 1991, in his 72nd year.

A military legion service was held on June 29th at the Collins and Hart Funeral Home. Legion members from the Dunnville Legion Branch 142 served as pall bearers and colour party. Charles was interred in the legion plot in Dunnville, the first veteran to be buried in the newly-purchased veterans' plot.

Charles, the youngest child of the late David Gordon and Bertha Crawford Gordon,

was born on the First Concession, Elgin, on December 7, 1919. He joined the Canadian Army during World War II, serving from 1942 to 1946. He rejoined and served in the Korean War from 1950 until 1952. Charlie then joined the Canadian Air Force in March, 1953, and upon his retirement in May, 1970, had reached the rank of Corporal.

After spending part of his retirement years in New Castle, New Brunswick, Charlie made his home with his sister and brother-in-law, Eleanor and Allan Smellie, first in St. Catharines, then in Dunnville, Ontario.

After suffering a stroke a few years ago he moved to the Grandview Lodge where he passed away.

Charles is survived by four sons, Bill, Keith, Frank and Richard, and one daughter, Jana, also six grandchildren and one great-grandchild. He is survived by one brother, Ira of Huntingdon, and one sister, Eleanor (Kay) Smellie of Dunnville, and several nieces and nephews.
