## Valleyfield by Elsie Melanson

### The Late Harold Hughes — 1918-1992

The Valleyfield Community was greatly saddened by the death of Harold Hughes, on Friday, 24 July 1992, at Le Centre Hospitalier de Valleyfield after a short illness.

The funeral Mass, held at the Valleyfield Basilica, at 11 a.m. Monday, July 27, and officiated by Fr. Gabriel Clement, was very well attended by many family friends and former work colleagues along with the family members.

Following the Mass, Harold was laid to rest in the Valleyfield Catholic Cemetery.

Harold was born and grew up in Montreal. In 1946 he met and married Marie Debeshevecus, also of Montreal.

The couple moved to Valleyfield that same year, where Harold was an employee at Asten Hill until 1953, when he accepted a position as Traffic Manager at the Valleyfield Schenley Distillery. A position he retained until his retirement in 1982.

In 1947, Marie and Harold became the proud parents of a son, they named, Robert, and in 1950 a baby daughter, Carole-Ann was born.

Harold was a very quiet, unassuming man, who took his responsibilities very seriously.

With time they both became highly respected citizens of this city.

They were members of the original St. Ignatius Guild, and Harold was eventually appointed a Trustee of the Guild.

He took over the presidency of the Guild in August, 1986, a position he retained until his untimely death.

He also held the position of President of the Schenley Retirees Club.

Harold will be sadly missed by this Community.
