## Argument ends in murder

An argument between two neighbours ended badly when one allegedly shot the other with a 12-gauge shot gun.

A Franklin man, Jean-Pierre Leger, 35, of #3425 Rte. 201 in Franklin was found shot to death around 7 a.m. August 23 in his car in a neighbours's driveway.

Huntingdon Surete officers responded to a call informing of gun shots at #3475, Rte. 201. The victim was taken to Barrie Memorial Hospital where he was pronounced

dead. The suspect was treated for shock and then arrested.

Jean-Guy Schinck, 23, was arraigned in Valleyfield court August 24 and charged with second degree murder and negligent use of a gun.

Police believe the argument started between Schinck the night before at a neighbourhood bar, according to statements made by witnesses. Later in the night Leger went to Schinck's house. Several neighbours called anonymously to report hearing gun shots.
