Valleyfield funeral for Frances Schaeffer, 78

The many friends of Frances Schaeffer (née Parry) were greatly saddened by her sudden death on Thursday, April 8, at Le Centre Hospitalier de Valleyfield, at the age of 78.

Frances was born in Valleyfield on March 16, 1915, the daughter of the late Percy Parry and Bertha Burton, also of Valleyfield.

Along with her three brothers, Robert, Sam and Leonard, she attended Gault Institute, from which she graduated. (Sadly she was pre-deceased by her brother, Robert).

She was the beloved wife of the late Sava Schaeffer, who also pre-deceased her in October 1983.

Frances was a specialist in the French language, and for a number of years was instructor for the second language at Gault Institute. She retired in 1979.

Following her retirement, she resided with her son, Peter Thompson and his family in Ile Perrot, but spent much of the time visiting with another son, Jim Thompson, of Albany, N.Y. She was pre-deceased by her eldest son, Robert Thompson, some years ago.
