

## Ft. Covington resident dies at 65 in Vermont

Frederick W. "Doc" Manson, age 65, of the Burns Road, Ft. Covington, N.Y. died Wednesday morning, Oct. 12, 1994, in the Burlington Medical Center, Burlington, Vt. where he had been a patient since September 20.

Born in Brandon N.Y., March 2, 1929, he was the son of the late Gibson and Blanche Hutchins Manson. He attended local schools. On April 28, 1951, he was united in marriage to the former Valencia Duheme in St. Bridget's Church in Trout River. She survives.

He was a dairy farmer for most of his life and was a farm equipment dealer and salesman in this area for many years.

Besides his wife, he is survived by one son: Bruce G. Manson of Ft. Covington; three grandchildren: Bruce Manson Jr., Amanda Lynn and

Gibson Manson of Ft. Covington; four brothers; Clayton Manson of Constable, Ariz., James Manson of Ft.
