Arthur Campbell, 68, dies in Muskoka, Ont.

Arthur Campbell, a Muskoka auctioneer and antique dealer died March 13 after a long fight against cancer. He was 68.

Although he had a long association with Muskoka, he was born in **Morin Heights, Que.**, and was educated at **Huntingdon Academy** and **McGill University**. He moved to **Bracebridge** in the 1940s, where he met his future wife, **Shirley**. They were married in 1951.

Loved antiques

Campbell built his auction and antique business, after a 37-year career with the **Brewers Warehousing Company**. He started with the company in 1949 and, after retiring in 1987, he returned to **Bracebridge** to pursue his long-time interest in Canadian antiques.

He was well known for his community service work with service

clubs and the **United Church**. He was made life member of the **Kinsmen Association** in 1965, and was also active in the **Lion's Club**. He had a long association with the **United Church**, serving on the boards of stewards in a number of communities, and conducting numerous charity auctions. He was also a founding member of the **Bracebridge Recreation Capital Fund Foundation**.

Arthur Campbell is survived by his wife **Shirley**; children and spouses **Terry and Christine**, **Mary and Brent Wisnicki** and **Margaret and Kelly Chee**; grandchildren **Michael, Susan, Stephanie, Graham, John, Nicholas, Emily and Mackenzie**; brother **Scott** and sister **Heather**; mother-in-law **Alma Elliott**, and stepmother **Stella**.
