Arthur Campbell, 68, dies in Muskoka, Ont.

Arthur Campbell, a Muskoka auctioneer and antique dealer died March 13 after a long fight against cancer. He was 68.

Although he had a long association with Muskoka, he was born in Morin Heights, Que., and was educat-Huntingdon at Academy and McGill University. He moved to Bracebridge in the 1940s, where he met his future wife, Shirley. They were married in 1951.

Campbell built his auction and antique business, after a 37year career with the Brewers Warehousing Company. He started with the company in 1949 and, after retiring in 1987, he returned to Bracebridge to pursue his long-time interest in Canadian antiques.

He was well known for his community service work with service clubs and the United Church. He was made life member of the Kinsmen Association in 1965, and was also active in the Lion's Club. He had a long association with the United Church, serving on the boards of stewards in a number of communities, and connumerous ducting charity auctions. was also a founding member of Bracebridge Recreation Capital Fund Foundation.
