Two women killed in crash near Franklin

Two young West Island women were killed in a Saturday-morning single-car accident on First Concession in Franklin, while a third passenger was severely injured. The driver escaped with minor injuries, the Huntingdon *Sûreté du Québec* reported.

Dead are 20-year-old Aneta Maslowska of Dorval and 17-year-old Hanna Kozdeba of Pierrefonds. Kusy Stanislaw, 18 of Montreal is expected to recover from his injuries.

Driver, Grzegorz Bialowas, 24, also of Montreal apparently lost control of his car, which spun around, crossed the road and smashed into a tree about 600 meters from Montée Clinton.

A police spokesman said that according to witnesses, speed may have been a factor in the accident. The investigation is continuing.
