Hunter shot near H'ford dies Nov. 13

A 68 year-old Ville-St-Laurent hunter, accidentally shot by anoth-er hunter November 3 near Hem-mingford, died in a Montreal hos-

pital last Wednesday Nov. 13. The unidentified victim was mistaken for a deer and shot by Claudio Zaccagna, 46, of Montre-al, who now faces a charge of criminal negligence with a firearm

resulting in death .

Shot in both arms, the victim inderwent extensive surgery at the Montreal General Hospital the day after the accident. He was resuscitated when he siffered a cardiac arrest on the operating table, and later was declared out of danger.

Unfortunately, be died on Wednesday as a result of two pul-monary embolisms, according to a local source.

Zaccagna's preliminary hearing is set for December 11 in St-Jeansur-Richelieu.
