"King of Havelock Fair" Jimmy Allen, 97, dies

This year's Havelock Fair will be without part of its soul it seems; following the August 26 death of 97 year-old James Allen, Havelock's oldest resident.

"Jimmy had become a central part of the fair, and of the community" said one Havelock resident who called the newspaper late last week.

In recent years, Allen had also helped with trophy presentations each year in the heavy horse competitions at Ormstown Exhibition in June, occasionally enjoying a ride around the arena with a winning hitch.

Jimmy Allen lived all his life in Havelock, where he was legendary for his amazing memory and his stories of days gone by. Active until the last short while, he held a driver's permit until just a couple of years ago.

He died following a brief illness at Ormstown's Barrie Memorial Hospital on Tuesday Aug. 26. Funeral services were held Friday at Trinity Anglican Church in Havelock.
