Fatal crash at Ste-Clotilde

A Hemmingford man was killed and four others were injured in a head-on collision around 11 p.m. on October 10 on Rte. 209 near Ste-Clotilde.

Dead is Vincent Ierfino, 45, a teacher at Chateauguay Valley Regional High School and a member of Hemmingford's Shoestring Theatre. His nine-year-old son Nicholas sustained minor injuries and is in stable condition at The Montreal General Hospital.

The other driver, a 23-year-old St-Chrysostome man, and one passenger were severely injured, while a third person escaped with slight injuries. The victims were taken by ambulance to Chateauguay's Anna Laberge Hospital for treatment.

A Ste-Martine Sûreté du Québec spokesman said that one driver had left about 50 feet of brake skid-marks trying to avoid the oncoming vehicle in his path, but slid into the opposite lane as the other driver corrected his course, resulting in the collision.

The coroner and the SQ are investigating the circumstances of this fatal crash.
