## Crash at Ormstown intersection kills two

A 38-year-old St-Louis-de-Gonzague woman and her 12 year-old daughter were killed instantly in a horrific collision at Ormstown early Saturday afternoon.

Another child was seriously injured in the crash, which happened when the minivan in which all three were riding was sideswiped by a sport-utility vehicle and thrust into the path of an oncoming semi-trailer truck.

Dead are Chantal Julien Maheux and her daughter Nadège, of Rang 30 in St-Louis-de-Gonzague. Maheux' eight-year-old son was taken to Ste-Justine's Hospital in Montreal in critical condition.

The accident occurred at the intersection of Rte. 138 and 138A, a busy crossing which has been the subject of a corre-

spondence between the School Governing Committee at Chateauguay Valley Regional High School and the Transport ministry.

In a letter dated January 7, 200, the school body called for a four-way stop to be instituted at the intersection, which currently only warns Rte. 138 traffic to slow down with a yellow flasher, while requiring cross-traffic on Gale St./Rte. 138A to stop.

In a reply dated January 25, a Transport department official said the CVR request was "under study".

The CVR letter states that regular traffic to and from the school includes some 140 crossings by school busses as well as cars and other vehicles traveling to and from the school.
