Ormstown woman dies following crash

An Ormstown woman aged in her 60s died following a single-vehicle accident in St-Stanislas-de-Kostka early on the snowy morning of Wednesday Nov. 22.

Mrs. Mickey Tasse of Ormstown's Upper Concession was a passenger in a pick-up truck driven by her husband. On Rte. 201 near the intersection of Rang 5, he lost control of the vehicle which skidded onto the snow-covered shoulder of the road before ending up in the ditch, police said.

Mrs. Tassé was unconscious when police arrived on the scene shortly after the 5:30 a.m. crash. She was taken by ambulance to hospital where she suffered a fatal heart attack shortly afterward. Her husband received minor injuries in the accident_
