Fatal car accident in Herdman

An 84-year-old man died in an automobile accident a little before 1:00 p.m. last Wednesday in Herdman.

The driver of a Buick Regal car, Rupert Wiggins, was traveling on Brook Road when he lost control of his car. The vehicle left the lane and hit a tree, not far from his place.

The octogenarian from Hinchinbrooke, who was traveling alone in his car, was taken to the Barrie Memorial Hospital in Ormstown where he was pronounced dead.

The Haut Saint-Laurent Sûreté du Québec police have not been able to find a reason for the accident. When the police inspected the scene, there were no signs of braking on the road.
