#### Young man loses his life in Très-St-Sacrement

A young man lost his life and two other people were seriously wounded in a road accident the night of October 31 to November 1 in Très-St-Sacrement.

The tragedy occurred towards 2 a.m. along English River Road. According to information from the Haut-St-Laurent detachment of the Sûreté du Québec, an Acura with three passengers ran off the road and travelled more than 100 metres in the ditch before crashing into a large tree.

One of the passengers, 21-year-old Ryan Dignard, died in the accident. He was
