Motorcyclist dies in Franklin accident

A 66-year-old man, Robert John McCarthy, died Wednesday morning following a motorcycle accident in Franklin.

The Athelstan man and his 45-year-old son were driving motorcycles along Route 202, where the tragic accident occurred at around 11:30 a.m. According to information from the Haut St-Laurent detachment of the Sûreté du Québec, McCarthy lost control of his motorbike coming out of a curve, swerved and crashed into a tree.

McCarthy's son, who was several metres ahead, did not see the accident. He turned around to see the shattered motorcycle, and further off, his father's body. He tried to revive his father, with

no success. Paramedics arrived to help, but could not do anything for McCarthy, who died on impact.

Officers of the Haut St-Laurent detachment of the Sûreté du Québec arrived on scene and blocked the road to investigate this tragedy. The police have not yet determined what caused the fatal accident. "It is impossible, for the moment, to determine whether the accident is the result of a problem with the driver, or an unknown defect in the vehicle. No brake or skid marks were found on the road by our agents," explained sergeant Robert Brabant, spokesperson for the Haut St-Laurent detachment of the Sûreté du Québec.
