

Fatal motorcycle accident in Ste-Barbe

A 40-year old man died in a motorcycle accident, which occurred at about 9:30 p.m. in Sainte-Barbe.

The victim, Sylvain Lavoie, was driving alone on his Harley Davidson on the chemin Bord-dc-l'Eau when he lost control of his bike. He was thrown from his bike that then careened off into a wooded area. His death was instantaneous.

A police investigation has been

opened to learn more details about the accident. According to first observations by the Haut Saint-Laurent Sûreté du Québec police, speed could be the cause of this tragedy. It seems that the driver, a resident of Sainte-Barbe, was seen rolling very quickly on the road that had a 30km/hour speed limit.
