Elderly couple die in car accident

A Franklin couple in their 80s died as a result of a two-vehicle accident on February 8 at around 8:30 a.m. on Rte. 209 near St-Antoine-Abbé in Franklin.

Bernard Deschenes, 81, and his wife, Séraphina Mangione Deschenes, 88, suffered fatal injuries and later were pronounced at Ormstown's Barrie Memorial Hospital.

Police believe the driver might have reacted to suddenly encountering a snow drift on a curve on his side of the road, swerved, lost control and crossed out of his lane and into the way of an oncoming

pickup truck, driven by a 30-year-old Franklin man, who struck the driver's door broadside. The driver of the pickup sustained minor injuries to his legs.

Franklin firemen needed the Jaws of Life emergency rescue equipment to free the victims from their vehicles. Life-saving efforts to revive the Deschenes were done at the scene.

Police say the weather conditions of blowing snow, poor visibility and slippery road surfaces likely contributed to the accident. The mechanics of both vehicles will be inspected. (PL/VF)
