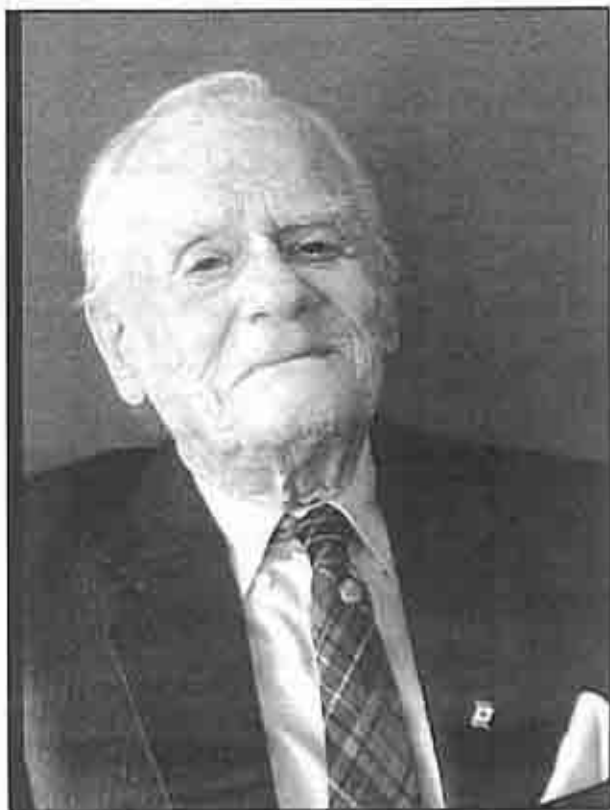
### CONGRATULATIONS

### Centenarian passes away at home



A farmer for most of his life, Mr. Douglas Sproule passed away at his home on the farm in Ormstown on July fourth in his 102nd year. Mr. Sproule was born in Ormstown in 1906 as the third child in a family of seven that included five brothers and one sister. He attended school at Ormstown Academy, and upon graduating he worked on the family farm, drove a delivery truck and a school bus before eventually settling down on Sprouledale, his purebred Holstein dairy farm with his wife Hilda Bryson. Together the couple raised a family and watched their farm expand until 1986 when his wife passed away. Mr. Sproule remained on his farm on the Lower Concession with his son. He never remarried. He is survived by his loving family, including son and daughter Harley and Shirley (Tom Vador), his many grandchildren and great grandchildren, and by all those whose lives he has touched.
