A young man died in a car accident early last Thursday morning at the intersection of Routes 132 and 236 in St-Stanislas-de-Kostka.

According to available information, the driver lost control of his vehicle, which veered toward a ditch filled with water.

The victim was 18-year-old Guillaume Sauvé-Dumouchel. He was taken to the Suroit Hospital in Valleyfield, where his death was registered.

According to police at the Sûreté du Québec's (SQ) Beauharnois-Salaberry station, the tragedy was not caused by excessive speed or alcohol consumption. It seems the young man fell asleep.
